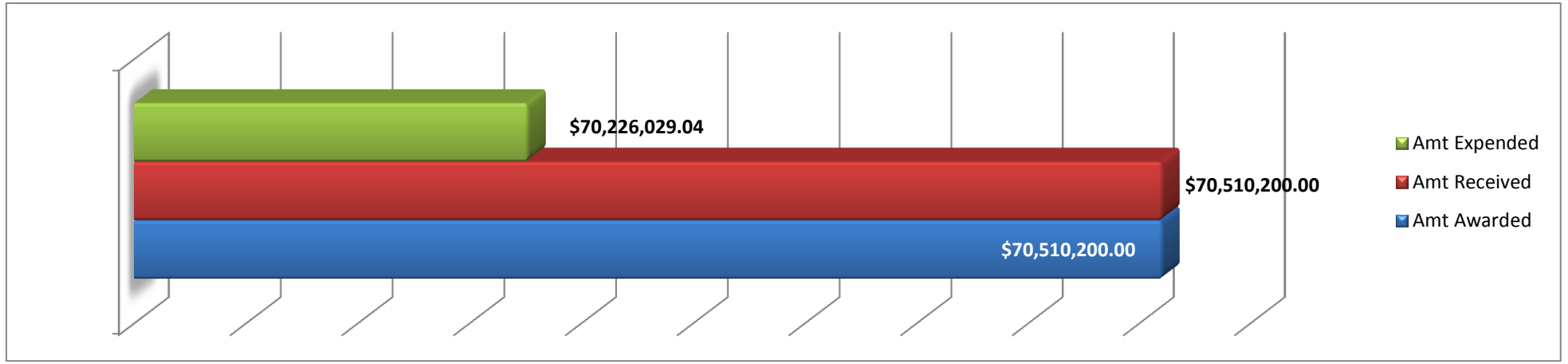

Amount Awarded: The total dollar amount of ARRA funds that an agency/institution is expecting to receive over the life of the grant/program.

Amount Received or Invoiced: The total cumulative dollar amount of ARRA funds received through draw-down, reimbursement or invoice.

Amount Expended: The total cumulative dollar amount of ARRA funds that the agency/institution has spent for the grant/program at the time of this report.

Quarterly Jobs Created/Retained: Quarterly Jobs Created/Retained are calculated by dividing the total number of hours worked and funded by the Recovery Act during the reporting quarter by the total number of hours in a full-time work schedule during the quarter. This yields the total number of full-time equivalent jobs (FTE) funded by the Recovery Act during the reporting quarter, but does not reflect jobs created/retained in previous quarters (or the lack thereof). Due to numerous changes in federal guidance on reporting jobs since the Recovery Act was passed the State of Alabama cannot accurately calculate the total number of jobs created/retained by Recovery Act funding over the lifetime of the Act.
